Lions (Kindergarteners)

Kindergarteners and their parents work together in activities that are age-appropriate and fun.

First-time Scouts, before advancement.



Tiger (1st Grade)

Youth and parents work one on one with other families to prepare Scout for Cub Scouting.



Wolf (2nd Grade)

Learn new hobbies and teach skills that will be useful during Scouting years.



Bear (3rd Grade)

Scouts meet regularly in small groups to work on projects. Uniforms, badges, games, sports, fun!



Webelos Scouting (4th & 5th Grades)

Scouts prepare to join a Boy Scout troop while learning outdoors skills and participating in many adventures.
